**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,

Understanding (MOU) with the Franchise Tax Board**

Whereas, the Probation department is responsible for collecting court ordered debt, victim restitution, fines and fees; and

Whereas, the County of Sonoma has historically participated in the Franchise Tax Board's Court Ordered Debt Collection program to facilitate collection of these payments; and

Whereas, an annual MOU is executed between the County and Franchise Tax Board to participate in this program; and

WHEREAS, the Franchise Tax Board's Court-Ordered Debt Collection Program is authorized to collect court ordered debts under California Revenue and Taxation Code (R&TC) Sections 19280 through 19283 and Penal Code Sections 1463.010 through 1463.012;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Chief Probation Officer or designee to enter into an annual MOU with the Franchise Tax Board to participate in the Court Ordered Debt Collection program.
