Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, Approving the FY 2025 Project List For The State of Good Repair Program

- Whereas, Senate Bill 1 (SB1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, established the State of Good Repair program to provide funding for eligible transit maintenance, rehabilitation and capital project activities that maintain the public transit system in a state of good repair; and
- Whereas, the County of Sonoma/Sonoma County Transit is an eligible project sponsor and may receive State Transit Assistance funding from the SB1 State of Good Repair program now or sometime in the future for transit projects; and
- Whereas, State Transit Assistance funding from the SB1 State of Good Repair program is allocated regionally by the Metropolitan Transportation Commission; and
- Whereas, in order to qualify for SB1 State of Good Repair funding, the County of Sonoma/Sonoma County Transit is required to submit a proposed project list to the Metropolitan Transportation Commission and California Department of Transportation on an annual basis; and
- Whereas, the County of Sonoma/Sonoma County Transit share of State Transit Assistance funding from the SB1 State of Good Repair program for FY 2025 is estimated to be \$39,315, which will assist with the replacement of compressed natural gas (CNG)-fueled buses with new battery-electric buses for the County of Sonoma/Sonoma County Transit fixed-route bus fleet.
- Whereas, the Director of Public Infrastructure, in his former capacity as Director of Transportation and Public Works, has been previously and remains authorized by the Board of Supervisors to execute all actions necessary for the purpose of obtaining State Transit Assistance funds under the State of Good Repair program;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the SB1 State of Good Repair Project List for Fiscal Year 2025 for the County of Sonoma/Sonoma County Transit.
