Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, Delegating Authority to the Chief Probation Officer to Apply for, Accept, and Execute Grant Awards and Related Financial Assistance

Whereas, Probation is actively pursuing grant opportunities to strengthen services, improve access to justice services and increase operational efficiencies; and

Whereas, the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors recognizes the importance of securing grant funding to strengthen Probation's ability to serve the community; and

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors deems it necessary to grant authority to the Chief Probation Officer or their designee to act on behalf of Sonoma County in applying for grant funds, from all Cal OES programs; the Judicial Council of California; the Board of State and Community Corrections; the California Department of Health Care Services; the California Department of State Hospitals; the California Office of Youth and Community Restoration; the United States Department of Justice and its component agencies, including the Bureau of Justice Assistance and the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention; the California Office of Traffic Safety; and other granting agencies; and

Whereas, the Chief Probation Officer is authorized to execute any grant award and related documents with review and approval of County Counsel, including extensions, modifications or amendments thereof;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that this authority will be in effect until this resolution is revoked or modified by a subsequent resolution of the Board of Supervisors.
