# Background

- September 2016: SB 1383 Signed into Law in Order to Reduce Emissions of Short-Lived Climate Pollutants
- June 2021: SB 1383 Board Workshop Conducted
- November 2021: Board Approved Amendment to Chapter 22 of the Sonoma County Code & MOU with Zero Waste Sonoma to Support Countywide Implementation of SB 1383



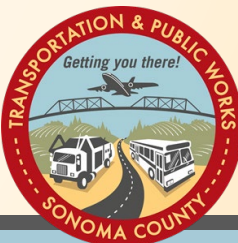
# Proposed Suspension of Mandatory Service

- Self-haul in lieu of franchised service is allowed
- Mandate not practical in rural areas – high cost of service
- Suspension of mandate does not compromise SB 1383 goals -- volume of self-hauled organic waste is < 15% of total



# Proposed Amendments to Franchise Agreements

- Offer Organic Collection Service to All
- Perform Routes Reviews, Contamination Monitoring and Reporting Services
- Adjusts Maximum Rates Haulers May Set, verified as reasonable by R3



# SB 1383 Maximum Service Rate Adjustment

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## Sonoma Garbage Company

- No SB 1383 Rate Adjustment

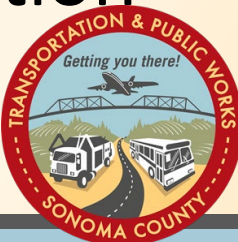
## Recology Sonoma Marin

- April 1, 2022 Rate Adjustment Not to Exceed 2.4%
- April 1, 2023 Rate Adjustment Not to Exceed 5.6%



# Proposed MOA Amendment

- Retire Existing Commercial Food Waste Collection Program and Incorporate Within Franchise Agreements
- Eliminate Associated \$4.21 Gate Fee which Funds the Program
- Increase the Waste Management Agency's Fee Cap on Self-Haul Waste by \$4.21
- Reduces Diversion Goal by 27,000 tons/yr to reflect elimination of diversion programs operated by Republic



# Staff Recommendations

- Approve Amended Franchise Agreements with Recology Sonoma Marin & Sonoma Garbage Company
- Approve Amended MOA with Republic Services & Authorize Related Changes to Prime Subcontract
- Adopt a Resolution Suspending Mandatory Subscription Obligations Established by Chapter 22 of the Sonoma County Code
