Description of fee:

The Department performs annual inspections of tow trucks to ensure that they comply with safety and consumer protection requirements as laid out in County code. This fee recovers the cost of performing these inspections, which are required for trucks to be licensed.

Reason for increase (e.g. statutory increase, cost of service increase):

The cost of providing this service has increased due to negotiated labor agreements and the increased cost of supplies. The cost has expanded at greater than average rate due to actual labor costs in the unit (benefit costs saw a greater than average increase) and a 10% increase in the cost of decals for inspected trucks (see attached analysis).

Description of methodology:

The tow truck inspection fee is a cost recovery fee and complies with Proposition 26 requirements. The fee is calculated by taking the total cost of providing the service, including labor, materials, and overhead, and dividing by the expected number of inspections.
