Concurrent Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California, the Board of Directors of the Sonoma County Water Agency, the Board of Commissioners of the Community Development Commission, and the Board of Directors of the Sonoma County Agricultural Preservation and Open Space District, Extending the 2023-2026 Memorandum Of Understanding Between the County of Sonoma and the Service Employees' International Union, Local 1021, for the Period of March 1, 2026 Through February 28, 2027.

Whereas, the Service Employees' International Union, Local 1021 (SEIU) is a recognized employee organization representing bargaining units 0001, 0005, 0010, 0025, 0080, and 0095; and

Whereas, the County met and conferred with representatives of SEIU to negotiate a one-year extension to the 2023-2026 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), as outlined in the Tentative Agreement, incorporated by reference as Attachment 2; and

Whereas, the SEIU membership ratified the terms of the tentative agreement to be recommended to the Board of Supervisors and Board of Directors for approval; and

Whereas, the terms and conditions of the tentative agreements are within the prescribed authority of this Board; and

Whereas, the County has satisfied its obligation under Government Code Section 3505 and the

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County Employee Relations Policy to meet and confer over the terms and conditions of

employment contained in the recommended MOU extension; and

Whereas, the Board has met all legal requirements under Government Code Sections 23026,

31515.5, 7507, and 31516; and

Whereas, the proposed changes to the SEIU MOU do not include changes in retirement

benefits or other post-employment benefits; and

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that this Board hereby approves the Tentative Agreement

setting the terms and conditions of the MOU extension between the County and SEIU, which

are attached and incorporated by reference herein.

Be It Further Resolved that the terms and conditions of the MOU shall be in full force and

effect from March 1, 2026, through February 28, 2027, except as specified otherwise in the

MOU.

Be It Finally Resolved that the County Executive, Director of Human Resources, and Auditor-

Controller-Treasurer-Tax Collector have the authority to take any necessary administrative

actions to implement the provisions of this resolution, including the authority to execute

administrative changes to plan documents and MOUs as needed and/or make corrections of a

non-financial nature.
