**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,  
Revising Resolution No. 21-0086 Establishing the Advisory Redistricting Commission to  
Increase the Composition of the Commission From 15 to 19 Members By Adding 4 Additional  
At Large Positions**

**Whereas,** following each decennial census, and using that census as a basis, the Board of Supervisors (Board) must adjust supervisorial district boundaries within the County so that the supervisorial districts remain substantially equal in population, as required by the United States Constitution; and

**Whereas,** on February 23, 2021, the Board adopted Resolution No. 21-0086 establishing the Advisory Redistricting Commission (“ARC”) for the purpose of making recommendations concerning redistricting to the Board pursuant to Elections Code sections 23001 and 23002;

**Whereas,** Resolution No. 21-0086 set the number of ARC appointed members at 15 comprised of 2 members from each district and 5 “at large” members appointed by the full board;

**Whereas,** the Board desires to increase the diversity of the ARC appointments and wishes to add an additional 4 “at large” positions to the ARC;
