**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,
Making Certain Findings; Authorizing The Location Of The PG&E Gas Line Easement; And
Authorizing The Chair To Execute An Easement Deed.**

Whereas, the Pacific Gas and Electric Company (“PG&E”) proposes to relocate a section of high-pressure gas line to avoid an unstable geological condition; and

Whereas, the high-pressure gas line will be relocated from a segment of an existing easement into a new easement segment; and

Whereas, Regional Parks staff and County Counsel have reviewed the proposed location of the high-pressure gas line and proposed easement and have concluded that it results in no harm or permanent damage to the park or the public’s use and enjoyment of the park, and

Whereas, Regional Parks will file a CEQA Notice of Exemption upon Board approval for said easement and high-pressure gas pipeline relocation; and

Whereas, PG&E has prepared an “Easement Deed.”

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma hereby finds, determines, declares and orders as follows:

1. Truth of Recitals. That the foregoing recitations are true and correct.
2. Authority to Sign Contracts and Documents. The Chair is authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of the County, an “Easement Deed” with PG&E

to effectuate the relocation of the high-pressure gas line across lands in Taylor Mountain Regional Park and Open Space Preserve.

3. Authorizing the Director of Sonoma County Regional Parks to execute related documents necessary to complete the transaction and file a Notice of Categorical Exemption pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act.
