**Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California,
Amending the Department Allocation List of the Human Services Department, to Delete 2.0
Full-Time Equivalent Home Care Support Assistant Allocations and Add 2.0 Full-Time
Equivalent Social Work Assistant Allocations, Effective March 3, 2026.**

Whereas, legislative and programmatic changes to the In-Home Supportive Services program requires Public Authority staff to complete tasks which are more in alignment with the responsibilities of the Social Work Assistant; and

Whereas, using Social Work Assistant positions will enable Public Authority staff to complete tasks and provide supports that better serve both clients and caregivers; and

Whereas, the Human Services Department will have more flexibility to utilize the incumbents as Social Work Assistants across the department, while also providing promotional pathways that do not exist for the current classification; and

Whereas, the Human Resources Department has reviewed the job duties of the position and determined that the job classification change is appropriate; and
