**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,
Authorizing Adjustments For Various Fees Supporting Marina Operations and Services And
New Fees For Self-Contained Camping – Waterfront And Non-Waterfront, General And Hourly
Parking, And Hourly Labor For Emergency Pump Out.**

Whereas, the County of Sonoma owns and operates sixty Regional Parks, trails and other facilities, including three marinas; and

Whereas, it is in the best interest of the County of Sonoma and the general public to maintain and operate said facilities and at a standard of care that provides for the welfare, safety and enjoyment of park visitors; and

Whereas, adjustments to various fees supporting Sonoma County Marinas will increase revenue to pay for these services provided to the fee payors; and

Whereas, new fees are recommended to help streamline marina operations and allow for additional services; and

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that to recover the reasonable cost of providing certain parks services, it is necessary to increase certain fees and establish certain new fees as set forth below:
