Quarterly County Grant Program Update - Third Quarter of 2024

Recommended Action:

Receive 2024 third quarter reports on departmental grant efforts.

Executive Summary:

The County's 2021-2026 Strategic Plan's Organizational Excellence pillar includes an objective to "secure a total of \$60 million in grant funding by 2026 for strategic priorities, including technology tools, climate resiliency, and other capital projects". The County Administrator's Office staff coordinates and provides quarterly updates to the Board of Supervisors on grant activities that accomplish this Strategic Objective and support County priorities.

This report covers grant activity from <u>July through September 2024</u>. This is an informational item only; departments will return to your Board as needed to seek any necessary grant-related approvals.

Discussion:

Since implementation of the County's Strategic Plan, county departments and agencies have secured the \$60 million objective target outlined in the Strategic Plan Organizational Excellence pillar. However, staff will continue to provide quarterly updates on grant activity to the Board and the public. Detailed information on grant activity in the reporting quarter is available in Attachment A, with new activity summarized as follows:
