






Project Location




New Intermediate Freestanding Telecommunication Facility

- Improved Access Road


Site Plan



Existing Coverage




Resulting Coverage – 70ft Tall Facility



Visual Assessment Faux Tree Designs Co-Dominant


Faux Eucalyptus: Current Proposal

BZA Hearing

Staff Recommended the Board of Zoning Adjustments approve the Project and find the Project exempt from CEQA

BZA Denied the project with the following findings:

- No service gap exists
- Alternatives not fully analyzed
- Alterative site 9845 Cherry Ridge Rd, Sebastopol would better meet service goals
- Visual impact not reduced by project design(s)
- Project detrimental to health safety and welfare

No new information was presented to the record for BZA denial

Public Comment

- Visual impacts cannot be eliminated through design
- Concerns of Micro Plastics Tree designs
- Impacts to private views and property value
- □ 5G exposure

Appeal

Project Applicant filed a timely appeal of denial:

- An in-building service gap exists
- 9845 Cherry Ridge Rd, Sebastopol not feasible, no landowner response
- A hypothetical alternative is not sufficient grounds for denial
- Visual impacts are reduced through stealth design and natural landscape buffers

Staff Recommendation

- Adopt a Resolution approving the Appeal and the Use Permit, subject to Conditions of Approval
 - Consistent with General Plan and DA Zoning Sec. 26-06-030
 - Consistent with Telecommunication Facilities Zoning Sec. 26-88-130
 - Faux Eucalyptus Tree design sufficiently reduces visual impact
 - No new information received to alter staff's original recommendation to BZA
- Find the project exempt from the California Environmental
 Quality Act under CEQA Guidelines 15303 (Small Structures)

Federal Telecommunications Act

- The Act preempts much of the local government decision making autonomy
- Local Government's Determination Is Limited To:
 - Whether or not a service gap exists
 - Whether or not the proposed facility is the least intrusive means possible to address the identified gap
