Dear Chief Moeser:

The Sonoma County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) is in the process of submitting the Equitable Sharing Agreement and Certification (Affidavit – Existing Participant) as required by the US Department of Justice (DOJ) for the fiscal year ended 6/30/25 to continue participation in the equitable sharing program.

The Affidavit Section states that the Sheriff and Governing Body Head declare under penalty of perjury that they have read and understand all obligations under the Guide to Equitable Sharing for State, Local, and Tribal Law Enforcement Agencies (Guide) and all subsequent updates. As the Sheriff and the Board of Supervisors are entitled to rely on knowledge and information provided by County Staff, the Affidavit should certify only their reasonable understanding of such information.

The enclosed Equitable Sharing Agreements and Certification, signed by the Sheriff and the Chair of the County of Sonoma Board of Supervisors, is being provided with the understanding that this is a *pro forma* document which does not require the Sheriff or Chair of the Board of Supervisors be personally involved in the matters being certified.
