SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE OF SONOMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 6257 TO ADD REPRESENTATIVES OF TRIBAL GOVERNMENTS AND ORGANIZATIONS TO THE GROUP OF AT-LARGE MEMBERS ON THE FIRST 5 SONOMA COUNTY COMMISSION.

On May 21, 2024, the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors conducted a public meeting to consider a proposed ordinance to amend Sonoma County Ordinance No. 6257 to add representatives of tribal governments and organizations to the group of atlarge members on the First 5 Sonoma County Commission. Said ordinance was passed and adopted by the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors on June 4, 2024. The ordinance amendment will take effect thirty (30) days after its passage.
