SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE OF SONOMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE SONOMA COUNTY CODE TO ADD NEW ARTICLE XXVIII. – ELECTRONIC FILING OF CAMPAIGN STATEMENTS.

On May 23, 2023, the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors conducted a public meeting to consider a proposed ordinance to amend Chapter 2 of the Sonoma County Code to add a new Article XXVIII. – Electronic Filing of Campaign Statements, to require the online or electronic filing of campaign statements, reports, or other documents required to be filed pursuant to Chapter 4 of the Political Reform Act. Said ordinance was passed and adopted by the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors on June 6, 2023. The ordinance will take effect thirty (30) days after its passage, and apply to all required filings of campaign statements, reports, or other documents after that effective date.
