Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,

Whereas, Assembly Bill 177 the state eliminated all ability for Probation Departments to collect fees from clients and amended underlying legislation to reflect the elimination of these fees.

Whereas, beginning Fiscal Year 2022-23 and ongoing the state provided replacement funding to Sonoma County to offset the loss of fee revenue and reduce the impact on local programs.

Whereas, the Chief Probation Officer and County Administrative Officer have determined that that this replacement funding will fund the Court Referral program and services provided by the Center for Volunteer and Nonprofit Leadership (CVNL) in order to provide meaningful community service opportunities for adults and juveniles required by the Court to complete service hours.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board is adjusting the FY 23-24 budget, increasing appropriations and reimbursement to the Probation Department Adult Services and Juvenile Services sections by \$300,000 to fund the Court Referral program, and that the County Auditor-Controller-Treasurer-Tax Collector and the County Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to complete the budgetary and accounting transfers and adjustments to the FY 23-24 budget as follows:
