COUNTY OF SONOMA CODE ENFORCEMENT AD HOC COMMITTEE CHARTER

Purpose and Background

In January 2025, the Board created a Code Enforcement Ad Hoc Committee and appointed Supervisors Hopkins and Rabbitt to the Ad Hoc. The Code Enforcement division of Permit Sonoma enforces all violations of codes under the Department's jurisdiction, abates public nuisances, and undertakes special projects such as enforcement of Public Health Orders. The Ad Hoc will work with the County Administrator's Office and Permit Sonoma to review current best practices in effective, fair, and transparent code enforcement within Sonoma County.
