**Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California,
Honoring Aidan Gaetano Fusco for Achieving the Rank of Eagle Scout**

Whereas, the Boy Scouts of America have a long and impressive history of preparing young men to assume responsibility in their communities; and

Whereas, Aidan Gaetano Fusco has been a member of Boy Scouts of America Troop 7 of Petaluma since 2019, began scouting as a Cub Scout in first grade, and has worked diligently and completed his ranking of Eagle Scout on April 21, 2026; and

Whereas, Aidan Charles has earned 32 merit badges: Automotive Maintenance, Animation, Aviation, Camping, Chemistry, Chess, Citizenship in Society, Citizenship in the Community, Citizenship in the Nation, Citizenship in the World, Communication, Cooking, Crime Prevention, Digital Technology, Emergency Preparedness, Engineering, Environmental Science, Family Life, Fingerprinting, First Aid, Fish and Wildlife Management, Kayaking, Mammal Study, Oceanography, Personal Fitness, Personal Management, Programming, Rifle Shooting, Small-Boat Sailing, Space Exploration, Swimming and Weather; and

Whereas, Aidan has served leadership positions including two years as Assistant Patrol Leader and one year as Troop Guide; and

Whereas, Aidan has attended three summer camps: Camp Winton, Camp Wente and has volunteered as a Camp Assistant for two years at Cub Scout Twilight Camp and also completed a 50 – mile canoe trip in 2025; and

Whereas, Aidan’s Eagle Scout Project consisted of designing and building a new “Prayer Space” for the Elim Lutheran Church in Petaluma which provides the youngest members of the church with an area and quiet activities that enable them to remain in the sanctuary during services.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors commends Aidan Gaetano Fusco on joining the outstanding group of Eagle Scouts.

Be It Further Resolved that the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors appreciates the effort which went into achieving that goal, and anticipates that Aidan Gaetano Fusco will have the heart and spirit of the Eagle throughout his adult life.
