

**First Amendment to Agreement for Personal Services  
County Executive**

This First Amendment to the Agreement for Personal Services by and between the County of Sonoma, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter “County”) and Maria Christina Rivera (hereinafter called “Employee”) is entered into this 13<sup>th</sup> day of January 2026. (County and Employee shall collectively be referred to as the “Parties.”)

**Witnesseth**

Whereas, County and Employee entered into a personal services agreement (the “Agreement”) for the position of County Administrator dated January 10, 2023; and,

Whereas, the Agreement provided for a term of employment for a period of three (3) years, commencing on February 1, 2023, and ending on February 1, 2026; and,

Whereas, the Parties desire to extend the Agreement for a period of up to three months, commencing on February 1, 2026, until May 1, 2026, or until a replacement County Executive can begin employment with the County.

Now, therefore, for good and valuable consideration, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

**Agreement**

1. All references in the Agreement to “County Administrator” are hereby amended to “County Executive”.
2. The Term of Employment provided for in the Agreement at Paragraph 1 shall be extended for a period of up to three (3) months to end on May 1, 2026, or until a replacement County Executive can begin employment with the County.
3. Paragraph 7(a) of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following language:

Employee may terminate her employment at any time by delivering to the Board of Supervisors Employee’s written resignation. Such resignation shall be irrevocable and shall be effective not earlier than fourteen (14) calendar days following delivery, unless waived by the Board of Supervisors. With the approval of the Board of Supervisors, a resignation may be rescinded at any time prior to the effective date of the resignation. At the request of the Board of Supervisors or with its approval, the originally scheduled date of retirement may be extended for any agreed upon period of time, but not beyond May 1, 2026.

4. Except as set forth above, all other provisions in the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
