When I was at the City of Santa Rosa, I served on my union's labor bargaining committee - Teamsters Local 856 - where I helped my members with a new three-year contract for our bargaining unit. I currently work for the CA State Assembly as the District Director for Assemblymember Chris Rogers.

I have a passion for public service and giving back to my community. I think I would bring a unique perspective to the Civil Service Commission. I have worked in public service since 2013 in roles with the County of Sonoma, City of Santa Rosa and the California State Assembly. Here is some background on my volunteer experience in Sonoma County: --Sonoma County Tourism Board, June 2023 to present I serve as a BOS appointee to the Tourism Board representing District 3 as a public member. I serve on SCT's Finance and Legal Committee and served on the Business Development Committee. --City of Petaluma Planning Commission - July 2017 to March 2022 I was appointed to the Commission by the City Council twice. I served in leadership roles on the Commission such as Chair, Vice Chair and 2nd Vice Chair. The Commission is responsible for major land use decisions, updating the General Plan and Zoning Ordinance, evaluating environmental impacts from development projects, and reviewing submissions for development projects. I was proud to be the youngest member of the Commission for the majority of my tenure on the Commission. I was a strong advocate for affordable housing, transit oriented development and inclusive housing policies. As a renter in Petaluma, I provided a unique perspective to the Commission. --Petaluma People Services Center - September 2020 to present I serve as a member of the board of directors for Petaluma People Services Center. Since earlier this year, I also now serve as a treasurer. As a Board we meet 4-5 times a year to oversee PPSC's finances and operations. --Sonoma County Public Library Foundation - September 2015 to September 2019 I served on the board of directors for the Library Foundation for four years. My stint on the Board included terms as President, Vice President and Secretary. I helped organize fundraising efforts, donor management, community engagement and outreach, providing critical funding for Library programs, setting up a fiscal sponsorship for the Roseland Library, and supporting the Free Bookmobile of Sonoma County. The Foundation, with my encouragement and leadership, took an active role in 2016 to ensure the passage of Measure Y. --Schools of Hope Volunteer, United Way of the Wine Country - August 2015 to February 2018 I volunteered at the Luther Burbank Elementary school once a week to read with students. My focus was usually with fourth grade students. I enjoyed reading with students and assisting them with their reading assignments. --Measure Y Citizens' Oversight Committee - July 2017 to July 2021 I was appointed to the sales tax oversight committee to review expenditures under the voter-approved Measure Y tax. During my time on the committee, I served as Vice Chair for one year. I helped oversee the Library's Measure Y budget and communicated with Library leadership regarding those funds and expenditures. -City of Petaluma Animal Services Advisory Committee - July 2019 to March 2022 I served as a member of this advisory committee - appointed by the City Council. We met a few times a year to review the nonprofit managing Petaluma's animal shelter and animal welfare programs.
