Whereas, Tesconi served as the executive director of the Farm Bureau for three years,

retiring in 2015; and

Whereas, Tesconi serves on the boards of several agricultural and community

organizations including: the Youth Ag & Leadership Foundation of Sonoma County, Santa Rosa

Junior College Ag Alliance, the Santa Rosa High School Ag Advisory Committee, past director of

the Sonoma County Farm Trails and serves as a trustee on the Richard and Saralee McClelland

Kunde Endowment that provides grants to support agriculture, fairs, 4-H and FFA; and

Whereas, Tim Tesconi has spent the last 50 years chronicling agriculture's changing but

enduring role in Sonoma County's economy and way-of-life.
