SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE OF SONOMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 6257 TO ADD REPRESENTATIVES OF TRIBAL GOVERNMENTS AND ORGANIZATIONS TO THE GROUP OF AT-LARGE MEMBERS ON THE FIRST 5 SONOMA COUNTY COMMISSION.
