SIDE LETTER BETWEEN

COUNTY of SONOMA AND SERVICE EMPLOYEES INERNATIONAL UNION LOCAL 1021 (SEIU)

July 15, 2020

The County of Sonoma (County) and Service Employees International Union Local 1021 (Union) have agreed to changes to the 2019-2023 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), as a result of the equity adjustments agreed to between the County and the Engineers and Scientists of California, Local 20 (ESC) and authorized by the Board on July 23, 2019. The salaries for the Supervisory classifications adjusted herein are administered based on the journey level benchmark classifications of the respective series represented by ESC. Negotiations with ESC, which occurred subsequent to SEIU's adoption of a successor MOU, resulted in salary adjustments to the journey level positions. Human Resources staff reviewed the Supervisory positions and recommended salary adjustments in order to address salary compression between the supervisory and non-supervisory levels of the classification series. The following changes will be effective upon Board adoption, August 11, 2020:
