This addendum is issued to furnish information that is supplemental to, will clarify, or modify the above-referenced solicitation.

**QUESTIONS:** The following are answers to all formal questions submitted by March 11, 2022:

*1. Are the chips staying on site?*

**Answer:** Contractor's Notes: #5, All waste materials removed must be hauled away and disposed of at proper disposal sites by the Contractor.

*2. For item #4m, why do the limbs need to be left on the ground for 24-hours after removal?*

**Answer:** The cutting of uninhabited branches (by bats) creates noise and vibrations that will cause any nesting bats to not return to the tree. If contractor wishes to remove the limbs then cut the tree and clean the area again, they may, but the cutting of branches must come first and then 24 hours later cut down the tree. All this is done after tree is dead.

*3. The Bid Book talks about using a chainsaw to girdle the trees, but on item #8 it talks about frilling on trees more than 4 in. in diameter, it is confusing. What size range are we girdling vs frilling?*

**Answer:** Girdle trees equal to or less than 4 inch diameter and frilling trees greater than 4 inch diameter.
