COUNTY OF SONOMA AGRICULTURE IN SONOMA COUNTY AD HOC COMMITTEE CHARTER

Purpose and Background

On May 6, 2025, the Board established an Agriculture Ad Hoc Committee and appointed Supervisors Hopkins and Gore to work with the Department of Agriculture/Weights & Measures and staff to assess the status of agriculture in the county and recommend polices to strengthen the agricultural industry and ensure its future viability in Sonoma County.

- Identify opportunities to clarify protections under the Right to Farm Ordinance and improve notification of the protections to better support agricultural uses on agricultural lands and decrease conflicts with surrounding residents.
- Analyze current Williamson Act program and ways of utilizing it as a tool to better keep land in active cultivation.

This ad hoc committee will generate a report identifying opportunities to strengthen agricultural industries for the Board to consider.
