

SUMMARY OF AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SONOMA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING NEW FEES AND ADJUSTING FEES EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2023 FOR THE SONOMA COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES PUBLIC HEALTH LABORATORY

On May 9, 2023, the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors adopted an ordinance adopting new fees and adjusting fees effective July 1, 2023 for the Sonoma County Department of Health Services Public Health Laboratory.

On March 21, 2023, the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors conducted a public hearing to consider an ordinance adopting new fees and adjusting fees effective July 1, 2023 for the Sonoma County Department of Health Services Public Health Laboratory. Adoption of fees will result in an overall net fee revenue increase of \$67,864. Areas of change include Microbial Disease Laboratory, Serology Laboratory, Clinical Molecular Laboratory, COVID-19 Testing, Environmental Laboratory, Virus Laboratory, Water & Shellfish Laboratory, Dairy Laboratory, and Miscellaneous Lab Fees.
