Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California, Authorizing the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights and Measures, or designee, to Accept Funding Allocations for the County of Sonoma and Execute Revenue Agreements, Amendments, and Related Documents Received through June 2031 as Necessary to Receive Revenue from Federal, State, and Other Related Agencies that Support the Regulations of the California Food and Agriculture Code, the California Business and Professions Code, and the California Code of Regulations to Promote and Protect Agriculture, the Environment, and Public Welfare Through the Enforcement of Local, State, and Federal Laws and Regulations.

Whereas, the County of Sonoma Department of Agriculture/Weights and Measures is eligible to receive certain funding through revenue agreements from federal, state, and other related agencies that support to promote and protect agriculture, the environment, and public welfare through the enforcement of local, state, and federal laws and regulations;

Whereas, standard agreements, amendments, and other related documents must be executed to accept allocations and permit receipt of such funds;

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors approves the annual budget which includes anticipated funding each fiscal year;

Whereas, the Department of Agriculture/Weights and Measures is 67 percent self-funded through these agencies and fees for services with approximately 20 standard agreements, amendments, and other related documents annually;

Whereas, approximately \$6 million in funding allocations from federal, state, and fees for services are anticipated to be received in fiscal year 2026-2027;

Whereas, the Department requests authority to accept funding allocations and to execute federal, state, and other related agencies' revenue agreements, amendments, and related documents that are in a form approved by County Counsel and received through the period ending June 2031.

Whereas, the Department believes it is a practical and efficient use of County resources to establish an exemption from County purchasing procedures delegating signature authority to the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights and Measures, or designee, to accept allocations from federal, state, and other related agencies and execute revenue agreements, amendments, and related documents.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma hereby delegates authority to the Agricultural Commissioner/Sealer of Weights and Measures, or designee, to accept allocations from federal, state, and other related agencies and execute revenue agreements, amendments, and related documents that are in a form approved by County Counsel and received through June 2031 as necessary to receive revenue from federal, state, and other related agencies.
