

## First Amendment To Agreement for Personal Services

### Agricultural Commissioner and Sealer of Weights and Measurement

This First Amendment to the Agreement for Personal Services by and between, the County of Sonoma, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter "the County") and Andrew Smith (hereinafter "Employee") is entered into this \_\_\_ day of March 2024. County and Employee shall collectively be referred to as the "Parties."

#### Recitals

Whereas County and Employee entered into a personal services agreement (the "Agreement") for the position of Agricultural Commissioner and Sealer of Weights and Measurement dated March 10, 2020, for a term of four (4) years pursuant to Agriculture Code section 2122;

Whereas County and Employee desire to extend Employee's term for an additional period of four (4) years ending on March 10, 2028, for the position of Agricultural Commissioner and Sealer of Weights and Measurement; and

Now, therefore, for good and valuable consideration, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

#### Agreement

1. Section 1., "Term of Employment," shall be amended as follows:

"1. Term of Employment. The County hereby employs Employee in the position of Agricultural Commissioner and Sealer of Weights and Measurement for the period commencing March 10, 2024, and ending on March 10, 2028, subject, however, to earlier removal from office pursuant to Food and Agriculture Code sections 2181, et seq., as herein provided."

2. Section 2. All references in the Agreement in Paragraph 3., Compensation and Paragraph 4., Performance review, to "Board," "Board of Supervisors," or "Board direction" shall be revised to include: "or CAO at the Board's direction."

3. Except as set forth in Paragraphs 1 and 2 above, all other provisions in the Agreement as modified by the First Amendment to Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
