SUBJECT: Selection of Pisenti & Brinker LLP for Financial Auditing Services

Sonoma County Water Agency and its affiliated sanitation districts (collectively Sonoma Water) require the services of an independent, impartial certified public accountant firm to audit their financial statements annually to comply with California Government Code and federal Office of Management and Budget requirements. The Office of Management and Budget also requires that a non-federal governmental entity, which expends \$750,000 or more in federal awards in a given fiscal year, have a single audit conducted in accordance with 2 CFR 200 (Uniform Guidance). The annual audits and single audits serve to showcase Sonoma Water's professional management, transparency, fiscal responsibility, and public accountability.

On February 21, 2024, Sonoma Water issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to the following 10 firms:
