Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, Approving The Grant Funds From Point Blue Conservation Science For The Taylor Mountain Wetland and Riparian Restoration Project.

Whereas, Point Blue Conservation Science received a block grant from the State of California Wildlife Conservation Board to re-grant to support projects that build wildlife-friendly resilience and equity on California's working landscapes, and

Whereas, Sonoma County Regional Parks will restore wetland hydrology, control invasive weeds, and plant native plants and engage diverse audiences to enhance mountain meadow wetland and riparian habitats at Taylor Mountain Regional Park over the course of the three-year grant project, and

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors Approves the acceptance of funding from the Point Blue Conservation Science; and

1. Certifies that the County will comply with all federal, state and local environmental, public health, and other appropriate laws and regulations applicable to the project and will obtain or will ensure that the other project partners obtain all appropriate permits applicable to the project; and

2. Further commits to the terms and conditions specified in the grant agreement; and

3. Appoints the Director of Regional Parks as representative of the County of Sonoma to conduct negotiations, execute, submit and sign all documents including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, payment requests, and other documents which may be necessary for the completion of the proposed project.
