### ALL COUNTY LETTER NO. 21-87

This ACL informs the County Welfare Departments (CWDs) of the October 2021 CalWORKs Maximum Aid Payment (MAP) increase pursuant to the passage of Assembly Bill (AB) 135 (Chapter 85, Statutes of 2021). This letter includes instructions for the implementation of the MAP increase, which takes effect on October 1, 2021.

- REFERENCE: WELFARE & INSTITUTIONS CODE (WIC) SECTIONS 11450, WIC 11450.022, WIC 11452, AND WIC 11453; ASSEMBLY BILL (AB) 135 (CHAPTER 85, STATUTES OF 2021); ASSEMBLY BILL (AB 85) (CHAPTER 24, STATUTES OF 2013); ACL No. 19-73

The purpose of this All County Letter (ACL) is to inform the County Welfare Departments (CWDs) of an increase to the CalWORKs MAP pursuant to the passage of Assembly Bill (AB) 135 (Chapter 85, Statutes of 2021), which was signed by the Governor on July 16, 2021. The CalWORKs MAP increase takes effect on October 1, 2021. This letter includes instructions to be used in the implementation of the 5.3 percent MAP increase and information regarding the effect the MAP increase may have on participants in the SB 380 Child Support in Lieu of CalWORKs Grant Option.

This policy change must be automated into the Statewide Automated Welfare Systems (SAWS) by the effective date to ensure recipients receive the correct amount of assistance they are entitled to. If the MAP increase and change to the Child MAP figures cannot be automated by the effective date, the SAWS must provide CWDs a temporary manual process to ensure that CalWORKs recipients receive the MAP increase no later than their date of issuance in the month of October and the correct Child MAP figures are applied when determining eligibility for the Child Support in Lieu

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of CalWORKs Grant Option. CalFresh recipients must receive notification of any negative changes to their household's CalFresh benefits no later than September 20, 2021 to meet (10-day) timely noticing regulations per 7 CFR 273.13(a)(1).

The AB 85 redistributed funds to counties for CalWORKs expenditures and established the Child Poverty and Family Supplemental Support (CPFSS) Subaccount within the Sales Tax Account of the Local Revenue Fund to support CalWORKs grant increases. The cost of the 5.3 percent grant increase will be funded with revenues deposited into the CPFSS Subaccount. Any remaining amounts in the subaccount will be carried over to future fiscal years. The growth revenues deposited into the CPFSS Subaccount will be monitored to determine if funding remains sufficient for the following fiscal year and thereafter.

Each year the subaccount will also be monitored to determine if funds are sufficient to allow an additional increase to the MAP. If funds are sufficient, the increase would take effect on October 1st of that year. If funds are not sufficient to support an increase, no change to the MAP will occur. The California Department of Social Services (CDSS) will notify CWDs in advance of any future grant increases.

The grant increase applies to all CalWORKs cases, regardless of whether the Assistance Unit (AU) lives in Region One or Region Two and regardless of the AU's exempt or non-exempt status. The CWDs are to treat the grant increase as a mandatory county-initiated mid-period action for Semi Annual Reporting (SAR) and Annual Reporting/Child Only (AR/CO) cases.

#### **INFORMING CALWORKS RECIPIENTS**

The California Department of Social Services (CDSS) has provided the attached mass mailer notice (TEMP 2250) for CWDs to send to all CalWORKs recipients, informing them of the change in state law that increases MAP levels effective October 1, 2021, and the potential decrease to the household's CalFresh benefits as a result of the increase to their income. The CWDs must begin sending the mailer to all CalWORKs recipients as soon as administratively possible but no later than September 1, 2021. As stated above, CWDs must also send the attached adequate notice of action (NOA) (TM44-315L) to CalWORKs recipients providing information specific to their AU's cash aid amount.

CalFresh noticing rules have not changed. AUs with CalFresh benefits affected by the grant increase will receive a separate notice about their CalFresh benefits. The CDSS strongly encourages CWDs to provide a copy of the TEMP 2250 to all new CalWORKs

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applicants who apply for aid starting in August 2021 through October 2021, to ensure that they are informed about the October 1, 2021, grant increase.

### UPDATED CHILD MAP CHARTS

The Child MAP charts are used in determining eligibility for participation in SB 380 Child Support in Lieu of CalWORKs Grant Option. CDSS developed the Child MAP charts showing the Child MAP by region, AU size and exempt/non-exempt AU's for single child and multi-child participation. CWDs use the figures in the Child MAP charts to determine if child support received on behalf of a child is greater than the amount of aid the child is eligible for. This is one criterion required for participation in the option.

The Child MAP charts need to be updated when there is either an increase in the child support disregard or if there is an increase in CalWORKs MAP. The attached Child MAP charts have been updated to reflect the statewide MAP increase effective October 1st, 2021 through December 31, 2021. The CWD will need to use the updated figures in the Child MAP chart to determine whether the participating child is still eligible for the SB 380 option.

The CWD will determine this eligibility step by comparing the current amount of child support the child receives with the updated figures in the Child MAP charts. If the amount of child support the child receives is greater than the figure in the updated chart, then the child is still eligible. As stated in ACL 20-109, page seven, under the County Initiated Mid-Period Actions section, if the child support received for the child is no longer more than the Child MAP figure, the CWD shall not add the child back to the AU's grant if it is not the SAR 7 or annual redetermination month for the AU.

The CWD may add the child back to the grant mid-period at the request of the parent/caretaker relative because the child support is no longer more than the amount the child would receive in cash aid. If at the next SAR or annual redetermination, whichever occurs first, the child support is still below the Child MAP figure, and the parent/caretaker relative has not already made the request, the CWD shall add the child back to the AU's grant.

The CWD will also use the updated Child MAP charts prospectively in determining eligibility when a parent/caretaker relative elects to have a CalWORKs eligible child in their home participate in the option.

#### FORMS AND NOTICES OF ACTION

<u>TEMP 2250 (7/21) – State Law Changes the Maximum Aid Payment Levels for</u> <u>Cash Aid Recipients</u> – This form was created for CWDs to send to all CalWORKs AUs All County Letter No. 21-87 Page Four

to inform them of the change to the MAP. This is a required form with no substitutes permitted.

#### TM44-315L (7/21) - NOA message - 5.3 Percent Grant Increase/Law Change - This

NOA message was created to send to cash assistance AUs when their grant will increase due to the MAP change. Instructions for use of the NOA message are included on the TM44-315L. This message is required with no substitutes permitted to the language. The CWDs may fill in case specific information as instructed.

#### Required Form – No Substitutes Permitted

Both the TEMP 2250 and the TM44-315L are Required Forms – No Substitutes Permitted. Forms in this category are required forms that the CWD may not modify or restructure. However, overprinting or reformatting under the conditions outlined in <u>Operations Manual Section 23-400.211</u>, <u>Overprinting Required Forms</u> and <u>Section 23-400.212</u>, <u>Electronic Date Processing (EDP) Modifications</u>, is permitted.

#### FORMS AND TRANSLATIONS

CWDs are required to provide CDSS translation to applicants and recipients in their primary languages when they are or become available. Until translations are available, recipients who have elected to receive materials in languages other than English must be sent the English version of the form or notice along with the <u>GEN 1365 - Notice of Language Services</u> and a local contact number.

The CWDs shall ensure that effective bilingual services are provided. When the percentage of non-English cases in a program and/or office location is less than five percent, this requirement may be met through utilization of paid interpreters, qualified bilingual employees, and qualified employees of other agencies or community resources. When the percentage of non-English cases in a program and/or office location is equal to or more than five percent, the CWD must assign a sufficient number of qualified bilingual employees to public contact positions in that program or location, as calculated pursuant to <u>MPP Section 21-115.1</u>. Language services shall be provided free of charge to the applicant/recipient.

CWDs shall use the figures noted as "child MAP" to determine if the amount of child support is greater than the amount the child would receive for CalWORKs (Please note for simplicity CDSS made the decision that income would not be a factor and a straight MAP would be used).

If the amount of child support received is greater than the "child MAP" for the child's AU size with the child included, region and AU type, the child is able to participate in SB 380 if all other conditions are met.

Example 1, child resides in region 1. The AU size would be 3 with the child included. It is a non-exempt AU so the base child MAP for the child is \$192.00, adding the \$50.00 child support "pass through" or "disregard", the total child MAP is \$242.00. The child receives \$300.00 in child support. Therefore, the child can participate if they meet the other required conditions because they receive more than \$242.00 in child support.

Example 2, same scenario as above except the child receives only \$150.00 in child support. The child cannot participate because the child support is less than the \$242.00 child MAP.

Counties shall use the figures noted as "Child MAP" to determine if the amount of child support is greater than the amount the child would receive for CalWORKs when the parent/caretaker relative has requested to have more than one child participate in SB 380 (Please note for simplicity the California Department of Social Services made the decision that income would not be a factor and a straight MAP would be used).

If the amount of child support received is greater than the "Child MAP" for the child's AU size with the child included, region and AU type, the child may participate in SB 380 if all other conditions are met.

Counties and the parent/caretaker relative may use the child support received by each child to determine who to assign as child 1, child 2 etc., when the children are opting into SB 380 at the same time based on the amount of child support it takes to meet the eligibility threshold for the child in the AU size/type/region and assignment of child order (child 1, child 2 etc.).
