First Amendment to Agreement for Personal Services Director of Emergency Management

This First Amendment to the Agreement for Personal Services by and between, the
County of Sonoma, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter "County") and
Christopher Godley (hereinafter called "Employee") is entered into this day of December
2021. County and Employee shall collectively be referred to as the "Parties."

Recitals

Whereas, County And Employee entered into a personal services agreement (the "Agreement") for the position of Director of Emergency Management of the County of Sonoma for the term December 24, 2018 to December 23, 2021; and

Whereas, the Parties desire to enter into a First Amendment to the Agreement to extend Employee's term for a period of three (3) years ending on December 23, 2024, and to increase the vacation accrual rate;

For good and valuable consideration, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

Agreement

- 1. Paragraph 1, "Term," of the Agreement shall be extended for an additional period of three (3) years ending on December 23, 2024; and
- 2. Paragraph 3 "Compensation" of the Agreement is amended to add a new paragraph (c) as follows:
- (c) As of the first pay period following the effective date of the First Amendment to Agreement, Employee's vacation accrual, administrative leave accrual, and maximum accumulation level shall be at the 20-25 years of full-time service level, as set forth in the Salary Resolution.
- 3. Except as set forth in Paragraphs 1 and 2 above, all other provisions in the Agreement as modified by the this First Amendment to the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
