

First Amendment to Agreement for Personal Services Director of Emergency Management

This First Amendment to the Agreement for Personal Services by and between, the County of Sonoma, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter "County") and Christopher Godley (hereinafter called "Employee") is entered into this _____ day of December 2021. County and Employee shall collectively be referred to as the "Parties."

Recitals

Whereas, County And Employee entered into a personal services agreement (the "Agreement") for the position of Director of Emergency Management of the County of Sonoma for the term December 24, 2018 to December 23, 2021; and

Whereas, the Parties desire to enter into a First Amendment to the Agreement to extend Employee's term for a period of three (3) years ending on December 23, 2024, and to increase the vacation accrual rate;

For good and valuable consideration, the Parties hereby agree as follows:

Agreement

1. Paragraph 1, "Term," of the Agreement shall be extended for an additional period of three (3) years ending on December 23, 2024; and

2. Paragraph 3 "Compensation" of the Agreement is amended to add a new paragraph (c) as follows:

(c) As of the first pay period following the effective date of the First Amendment to Agreement, Employee's vacation accrual, administrative leave accrual, and maximum accumulation level shall be at the 20-25 years of full-time service level, as set forth in the Salary Resolution.

3. Except as set forth in Paragraphs 1 and 2 above, all other provisions in the Agreement as modified by the this First Amendment to the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
