Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California, Designating Crestwood Sonoma County Healing Center as an Involuntary Detention Facility for the Purpose of Assessment, Evaluation, and Treatment of Adults Who are a Danger to Others, Danger to Themselves, or **Gravely Disabled Pursuant to the Lanterman-Petris-Short Act** 

Whereas, the Lanterman-Petris-Short Act, codified at Welfare and Institutions Code sections 5000 through 5587, allows a facility to provide 72-hour assessment, evaluation, and treatment for adults and minors with a mental health disorder on an involuntary basis if the facility is designated by the County and approved by the Department of Health Care Services;

Whereas, Crestwood Behavioral Health operates a 16-bed Psychiatric Health Facility located at 7440 Los Guilicos Road in Santa Rosa, known as Crestwood Sonoma County Healing Center ("Crestwood Sonoma") and seeks designation under the LPS Act as a 72-Hour Assessment, Evaluation, and Treatment Facility pursuant to Sections 5150 and 5250 of the California Welfare and Institutions Code; and

Whereas, Crestwood Sonoma satisfies the requirements of Title 9 California Code of Regulations Section 663.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that Crestwood Sonoma is designated as a facility for 72-hour assessment, evaluation, and treatment pursuant to Sections 5150 and 5250 of the Welfare and Institutions Code.
