## Description of methodology:

Regional Parks' current fee for a campsite is \$39 per night. This cost per night is consistent and in the median price range with other agencies such as California State Parks, East Bay Regional Parks and local KOAs. The price for electrical hookups at these sites range from \$40 to \$95 per night. The median is \$65 per campsite, per night for electrical hookups. Regional Parks is proposing raising the current electrical hookup fee from \$10 to \$12 per night, per campsite that has electrical hookups. This puts the total cost at Regional Parks for a campsite with electrical hookups at \$51 per night. An annual adjusted CPI of 3% increase per year from 2016, would lead to roughly a 17% increase and result in a fee of \$12 per night for 2022, which is consistent with the current fee recommendation.
