SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE OF SONOMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO ESTABLISH THE FEES TO BE COLLECTED BY THE SHERIFF-CORONER'S OFFICE

On March 22, 2022, the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors conducted a public hearing to consider the proposed ordinance to establish fees to be collected by the Sheriff-Coroner's Office, including an overall net fee revenue increase of \$29,052. Areas of change include a projected revenue increase in the Central Information Bureau, a revenue increase in the Coroner Bureau, a revenue increase in the Patrol Bureau, and a revenue increase in the Telecommunications Bureau. These proposed fee changes would take effect on July 1, 2022 and are necessary to recover the reasonable cost to provide these services.
