**Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,
authorizing the District Attorney to participate in the Marginalized Victims Program
and to execute a contract with the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services
for Calendar Year 2022 in the amount of \$202,793.**

Whereas, the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors and the Sonoma County District Attorney desire to continue a certain program designated as the Marginalized Victims Program as a provider of enhanced survivor-driven advocacy, counseling, housing assistance, and referral services for the foster care youth ages 5 to 24 in Sonoma County; and

Whereas, the continuation of the Innovative Response to Marginalized Victims program is to be funded in part from funds made available through a federal Victims of Crime Act Victim Assistance Formula Grant Program made available through California Governor's Office of Emergency Services; and

Whereas, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services has allocated \$202,793 to the County of Sonoma for the 2022 Calendar Year.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the District Attorney for the County of Sonoma is authorize, on behalf of this body to accept a grant for the Marginalized Victims Program and is authorized to execute on behalf of the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors the Grant Award Agreement including any extensions or modifications thereof.

Be It Further Resolved that the grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.
