Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California,

Honoring and Commending the Petaluma Educational Foundation on the

Occasion of its Fortieth Anniversary

Whereas, in 1982, a group of teachers, business leaders and community activists in Petaluma created the Petaluma Educational Foundation (PEF), a privately funded, non-profit organization, whose primary goal is to raise money in the community to benefit education; and

Whereas, the mission of PEF is to create impactful educational opportunities for all students in the Petaluma community by funding programs that promote critical thinking, creativity, student well-being and lifelong learning; and

Whereas, since the inception of PEF in 1982, a total of \$8,149,877 in financial support has been awarded through the grant and scholarship programs. This funding was raised from individuals, corporations, foundations and the proceeds from the PEF managed Alphabet Thrift Stores; and

Whereas, PEF funds: Grants to Schools - which funds projects not covered in the school budget for the purpose of rewarding innovative academic programs and fostering excellence in education in all Petaluma schools, and Scholarships for High School Seniors – which includes 77 Scholarship Programs for seniors graduating from all seven Petaluma High Schools;
