### Interdepartmental Multidisciplinary Team (IMDT) Cohorts

The Behavioral Health Homeless / Care Coordination Expenditure Category is 1 of 2 remaining categories to still have funding unallocated. County Staff are formulating proposals for an organization structure and funding amounts for the IMDT Cohorts with the Behavioral Health Homeless / Care Coordination funding. County Staff presented an overview and options for a City-County Partnership of the IMDT Cohorts to the City-County Staff Homeless Committee on February 24<sup>th</sup> and the City Managers on March 17<sup>th</sup>.

### Mobile Support Team (MST) Expansion / Crisis, Assessment, Prevention, and Education (CAPE)

The Mobile Support Team (MST) Expansion / Crisis, Assessment, Prevention, and Education (CAPE) is the other remaining category to still have funding unallocated. County staff are working with school superintendents and SCOE leadership to put together a proposal to increase Behavioral Health services for students in our public school system. The Ad Hoc has met with school leaders on 12/6/21 and 2/7/22 and will meet again one more time to finalize the recommendation.
