Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, Increasing Compensation to be paid to Election Vote Center Workers

Whereas, the citizens who staff vote centers during elections are critical to the fair and efficient conduct of elections in Sonoma County; and

Whereas, the complexity of conducting elections has increased dramatically in recent years and the use of trained and experienced personnel at the vote center level is critical to the efficient conduct of elections; and

Whereas, the vital service provided by vote center staff is not reflected in the amount they are paid; and

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors acknowledges the importance of vote center workers and finds it necessary to increase compensation pay.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, that the stipend paid to vote center workers shall be fixed at the following rates, effective May 25, 2022.
