Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, Authorizing the Sonoma County Auditor-Controller Treasurer-Tax Collector to Reissue Warrants With Voided Dates of Greater Than Two Years

Whereas, unclaimed funds in the amount of \$7,194.77 are on deposit in the Auditor's Tax Clearing trust fund representing funds voided over two years ago issued for overpayment of property taxes; and

Whereas, the Auditor-Controller Treasurer-Tax Collector's (ACTTC) Property Tax Division has identified the original payees of the previously unclaimed funds and in order to avoid an inequitable result, would like to reissue the warrants to their intended owners; and

Whereas, California Government Code Section 29802(a) provides that any warrant issued is void if not presented to the County Treasurer for payment within six months after the date of issue; and

Whereas, California Government Code Section 29802(c) provides that the governing body may, by resolution, authorize the Auditor to draw new warrants after a period of two years from the date on which the original warrant became void; and

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved, That pursuant to the provisions of Government Code Section 29802(a) and 29802(c) the Auditor-Controller Treasurer-Tax Collector may reissue previously unclaimed funds voided over two years ago, to their intended payees.
