Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California, delegating authority to the Sheriff-Coroner to execute facility use agreements for trainings held at non-county owned facilities.

Whereas, The Sheriff's Office conducts various POST-certified tactical training exercises throughout the year, such as tactical breaching, tactical operations, tactical team training, and tactical firearms training, which may be conducted at non-county owned, off-site facilities; and

Whereas, The Sheriff's Office occasionally also uses off-site facilities to hold other non-tactical trainings, and

Whereas, non-County owned training facilities may offer ideal, cost-effective locations for these law enforcement trainings and lodging; and

Whereas, non-county owned facility use agreements oftentimes include indemnification and liability waiver provisions that require authorization of the Board of Supervisors; and

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Board of Supervisors that authority is delegated to the Sonoma County Sheriff-Coroner to execute non-county owned facility use agreements in consultation with County Counsel and Risk Management, provided that the annual aggregated amount of training facility use agreements does not exceed \$50,000.
