<p>Purpose and Scope</p> <p>The purpose of the EDB Ad Hoc is to guide the EDB as the Department transitions through interim leadership, and create a sustained vision for both local and multi-jurisdictional economic development programming.</p> <p>This vision will be created in partnership with the Board and with input from business and community leaders, and provide a strong backbone for permanent department leadership, as well as a framework for collaborative economic development efforts.</p> <p>The scope of work to be completed over the course of calendar year 2022 includes the following:</p> <p>April – June 2022 – Take Stock:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Assess the current structure and programming of the Economic Development Board – what is working, what is not, what is needed? 2. Track and support ARPA effort, as a broad multi-sectoral partnership in support of equity, small businesses and recovery. 3. Identify missed opportunities with respect to current focus and capacity. <p>July – December 2022 – Structure and Focus:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Communicate the need to reinvigorate relationship with local businesses and community. 2. Conduct listening sessions with broad cross-section of stakeholders (cities, chambers, trade, equity groups) 3. Identify potential focus areas and structures that emphasize and encourage collaboration
