

**SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE OF
SONOMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REPEALING AND REPLACING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE XX, OF THE SONOMA COUNTY CODE,
ESTABLISHING CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION LIMITS.**

On August 9, 2022, the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors will conduct a public meeting to consider a proposed ordinance to repeal and replace Chapter 2, Article XX of the Sonoma County Code, establishing Campaign Contribution Limits. The proposed ordinance would take effect on January 1, 2023, and would apply to all elections conducted after that effective date.
