Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma, State of California, Honoring Kai Kisling for Achieving the Rank of Eagle Scout

Whereas, the Boy Scouts of America have a long and impressive history of preparing young men to assume responsibility in their communities; and

Whereas, Kai Kisling has been a member of Boy Scouts of America Troop 74 of Petaluma for seven years, and has worked diligently and completed his ranking of Eagle Scout, and

Whereas, Kai has earned 22 merit badges, served in many leadership positions including, Patrol Leader, Assistant Senior Patrol Leader and Junior Assistant Scoutmaster, attended summer camps in Camp Fleishmann, Camp Chawanakee and Camp Wente (twice) and whose favorite outings were the 50 mile backpacking trips held every summer, Fordyce Creek backpacking trips, and the Eel River kayaking trip; and

Whereas, Kai's Eagle Scout Project consisted of moving and refurbishing a gardening shed for the Wilson School, Petaluma, gardening program as well as directing his team in assembling and constructing a Gaga Ball Pit for the students to play during recess and P.E. This required drilling holes, prepping and painting, leveling the shed structure, cutting boards down to the correct size, and various other tasks. This project was completed in one day in approximately eight hours with 20 plus volunteers.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors commends Kai Kisling on joining the outstanding group of Eagle Scouts.
