SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE OF SONOMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REPEALING AND REPLACING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE XX, OF THE SONOMA COUNTY CODE, ESTABLISHING CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION LIMITS.

On August 9, 2022, the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors conducted a public meeting to consider a proposed ordinance to repeal and replace Chapter 2, Article XX of the Sonoma County Code, establishing Campaign Contribution Limits. Said ordinance was passed and adopted by the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors on August 30, 2022. The ordinance will take effect on January 1, 2023, and apply to all elections conducted after that effective date.
