**Resolution of the Board of Supervisors, County of Sonoma, State of California,
Congratulating North Bay Regional Center celebrating 50 years of service**

WHEREAS, North Bay Regional Center provides advocacy, services, support, and care coordination to children and adults diagnosed with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their families in Napa, Sonoma, and Solano Counties; and

WHEREAS, North Bay Regional Center is one of 21 Regional Centers for persons with developmental disabilities in California and serves over 10,000 people living within the geographic boundaries of Napa, Sonoma, and Solano; and

WHEREAS, North Bay Regional Center offers two programs for people receiving services, Early Start and the Lanterman Program where Early Start is a federally funded program for infants and children ages birth to 3 years focusing on early intervention services, who qualify due to a significant delay in at least one area of their development, or have an established or high risk condition and the Lanterman Program is funded through both state and federal contracts and is for children 3 years and older, adolescents, and adults diagnosed with a developmental disability such as Intellectual Disability, Autism, Epilepsy and Cerebral Palsy, thus centered around a lifetime of services; and

WHEREAS, North Bay Regional Center is committed to providing the highest quality of services to their clients, which are individualized and must be related to the client's eligible disability. Such services include, Diagnosis and Evaluation, Individual Program Planning, Prevention Services, Crisis Intervention, Advocacy, Individualized Family Support Services, Transition Planning, and other case management supports.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Sonoma do hereby Congratulate North Bay Regional Center on their 50th Anniversary of supporting individuals with developmental disabilities and their families.
