Dear Ms. Hulette:

FEMA has completed its review of the *Sonoma County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan Update*, as it pertains to the newly eligible participating jurisdiction, the Sonoma County Agricultural Preservation and Open Space District, and has found the plan to continue to be in conformance with Title 44 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Part 201.6 *Local Hazard Mitigation Plans*. The Sonoma County Agricultural Preservation and Open Space District must adopt the plan within five calendar years of the date of the plan approval date.

The adoption of the plan by each jurisdiction ensures that jurisdiction's continued eligibility for funding under FEMA's Hazard Mitigation Assistance (HMA) programs. All requests for funding, however, will be evaluated individually according to the specific eligibility, and other requirements of the particular program under which applications are submitted.

FEMA's approval of the *Sonoma County Multi-jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan Update 2021* remains for a period of five years from the original approval date of **October 13, 2021** for all approved participants. This plan eligibility amendment will not alter the approval date that had originally been established. An updated list of the current status of participating jurisdictions is enclosed with this letter.

Prior to October 13, 2026, Sonoma County and all participating jurisdictions are required to review and revise the plan to reflect changes in development, progress in local mitigation efforts, and changes in priorities, and resubmit it for approval in order to continue to be eligible for mitigation project grant funding.
