Resolution of The Board of Supervisors of The County of Sonoma, State of California,

Authorizing the District Attorney to Sign an Agreement with the California Office of

Emergency Services for Federal Fiscal Year 2022-23 in the amount of \$827,815.

**Whereas,** the Sonoma County District Attorney desires to continue a certain project designated as the Victim/Witness Assistance Program.

**Whereas,** Victim Services Division of the Sonoma County District Attorney's Office, is the provider of comprehensive and emergency victim and witness services in Sonoma County; and

**Whereas,** the California Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) has allocated \$827,815 to the County of Sonoma for the term October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023.

**Now, Therefore,** Be It Resolved that the District Attorney of the County of Sonoma is authorized, on behalf of this body, to accept a grant for the Victim/Witness Assistance Program from the California Office of Emergency Services and is authorized to execute on behalf of the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors the Grant Award Agreement including three one-year extensions or modifications thereof.

**Be It Further Resolved** that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body, and will hold CalOES harmless from any claims that arise from the use of grant monies.
