Resolution Of The Board Of Supervisors Of The County Of Sonoma, State Of California,

Honoring And Acknowledging Sebastopol City Councilmember Patrick Slayter For Twelve

Years Of Exemplary Public Service To The People Of Sebastopol.

Whereas, Patrick Slayter was first elected to the Sebastopol City Council in 2010 and has provided the people of Sebastopol with stable and responsive governance for twelve years until 2022; and

Whereas, Councilmember Slayter served four terms as Mayor in 2015, 2018, 2020, and 2022; and

Whereas, during his dedicated service on the council, Mr. Slayter has served on a wide variety of committees such as the City of Sebastopol's Agenda Review Committee, Community Design Standards Review Subcommittee, Housing Subcommittee, Emergency Preparedness Subcommittee, Disaster Council Review Subcommittee, Caltrans Interface Subcommittee, Zero Waste Subcommittee, Pedestrian, Bicycling and Public Transit Subcommittee, and the CVS Property Design Subcommittee; and

Whereas, over the course of his tenure, Patrick Slayter has fortified the vitality of the Sebastopol community with his service as Liaison to the Sebastopol World Friends Sister City Organization, the Sebastopol Chamber of Commerce, the Sebastopol Area Senior Center, and the Sebastopol Center for the Arts; and

Whereas, Councilmember Slayter was instrumental in the launch of Sonoma Clean Power, a statewide model for Community Choice Aggregation helping to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by providing access to higher percentages of renewable energy to residents and businesses, and for serving as the Sebastopol Representative on the agency's Board of Directors including two terms as Chair for two terms; and

Whereas, in 2013 Councilmember Slayter co-authored Sebastopol's pioneering Photovoltaic Ordinance requiring the installation of solar photovoltaic systems for all new commercial and residential building construction and some additions, further decreasing the Resolution #22-Date: November 8, 2022 Page 2

greenhouse gas emissions generated within the city.

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved that the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors does hereby honor and acknowledge City of Sebastopol Mayor Patrick Slayter for twelve years of exemplary public service to the people of Sebastopol, and sincerely thanks him for his good work.
